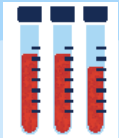
## THE VISUAL DENTAL EXAMINATION

It's hard to miss **bad breath**, but not all signs of dental disease are as easily detected. Your veterinarian will look for other tell-tale indicators, like:

- plaque & tartar build-up
- discolored teeth
- broken teeth; loose teeth
- swollen gums; bleeding gums
- pawing at the face & mouth
- excessive drooling
- difficulty chewing
- decreased appetite

## 2. PRE-ANESTHETIC EVALUATION

To maximize safety and minimize the risks associated with anesthesia, a resting electrocardiogram will be read by a cardiologist and blood will be collected to confirm:



heart, kidney, liver, and pancreatic functions are safe for sedation and recovery; there are no underlying concerns or conditions that increase risk; and your pet is not dehydrated or suffering from an electrolyte imbalance

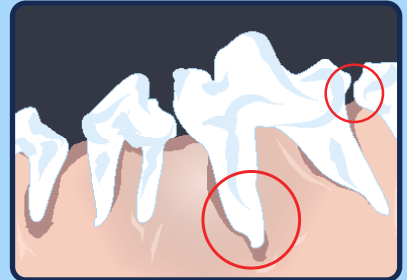
*Your pet will be kept warm and comfortable, and given a low-dose of pre-anesthetic medication to help him or her relax.*

## 3. ANESTHESIA & MONITORING

**Anesthesia** enables us to perform the dental cleaning safely with the least amount of pain or stress to your pet.

**Cardiac monitoring** allows us to record heart rhythms and blood pressure levels during the dental cleaning.

*Most dental disease is out of sight, below the gum line.*

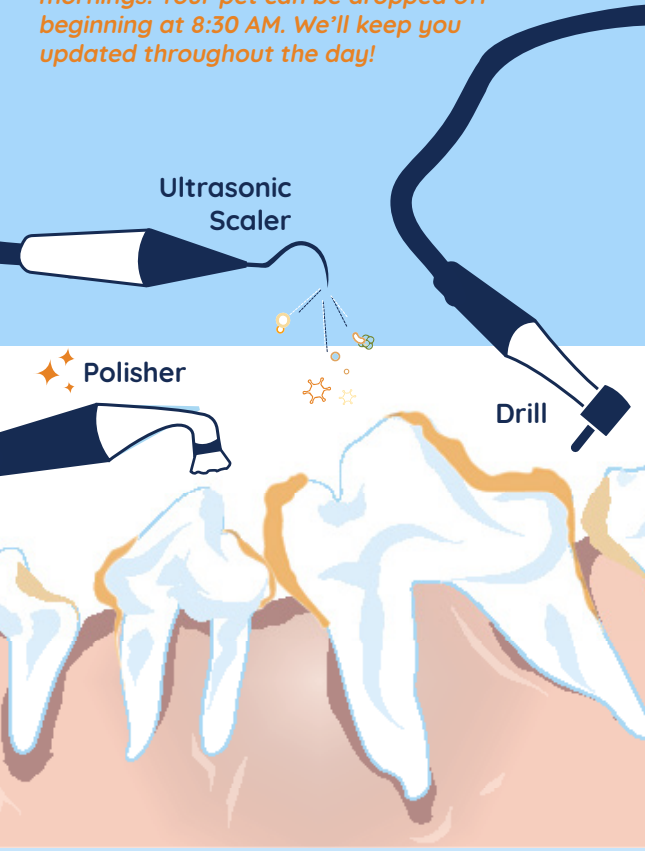


## 4. DIGITAL DENTAL RADIOGRAPHY

Digital dental radiographs help us to:  
identify diseased, broken, and fractured teeth;  
detect subgingival masses, infection, and foreign objects;  
and confirm treatment success

## 5. THE PROFESSIONAL DENTAL CLEANING

Dental cleanings are performed in the mornings. Your pet can be dropped off beginning at 8:30 AM. We'll keep you updated throughout the day!



The oral cavity will be deep cleaned above and below the gum line using modern dental equipment that is similar to what you would expect to find at the human dentist office.

**SCALING** removes plaque and tartar accumulation from above and below the gum line. Oral bacteria begins and lives in the gum tissue, so we always clean below the gum line first.

**POLISHING** smooths the surface of the teeth. This is required to make the teeth resistant to future plaque formation.

**FLUSHING AND DISINFECTING** removes dislodged tartar and helps to remove any bacteria that are present.

**EXTRACTIONS\*** of non-functional teeth (damaged, loose, decayed, etc.) effectively alleviates pain and prevents further infection.

### AT-HOME CARE & PICK-UP

Always purchase pet-friendly dental products! Human dental products can be toxic to pets.

Be proactive at maintaining your pet's improved dental health. Your pet will return home the same day, and we'll show you how to brush your pet's teeth between visits. For less tolerant pets, we can recommend alternatives such as dental chews and oral rinses.
